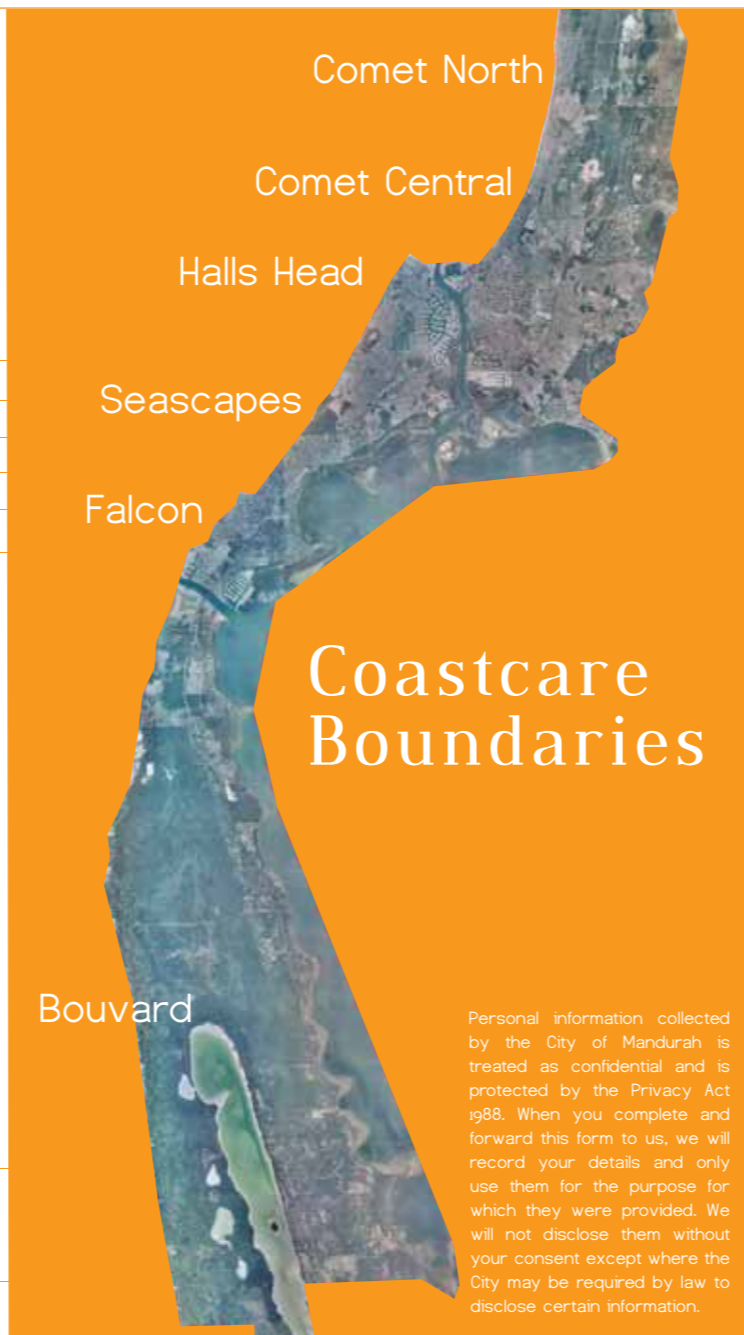

Do your bit to protect Mandurah's coastal area

Protecting the natural vegetation and dune surfaces will reduce the risk of blow-outs from wind and destabilised dunes being blown inland or washed out to sea.

- Use the access paths provided
- Don't sandboard on the dunes
- Pick up litter on the beaches
- Don't dump garden rubbish in the dunes as this will create weed problems
- 4 wheel driving and riding motor bikes in the dunes will cause significant permanent damage

What are Coastcare groups?

There are six Coastcare Groups in Mandurah and the dedicated members of these groups work in partnership with the City of Mandurah to help protect our coast. Hundreds of volunteer hours have been spent brushing and planting dunes, formalising access tracks, putting up fences and monitoring the coast. A lot of this work has been done with the financial assistance from the State and Commonwealth Governments and matching funds from the City of Mandurah.
